- Observe a 14-day quarantine period after entering the state
- Remain indoors if sick
- Social distancing must be followed by all tenants, in and out of doors
- Gatherings of ten or fewer only, including at the beach
- Maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet from others
- Wear a mask in public
- The HBRF beach at Mirror Lake is for members of the Hubbard Brook community and their families. It is not open to the public.
- Shared HBRF canoes and other water sports equipment will be available according to the availability of disinfecting wipes. Please wipe equipment before and after each use.
